

**INUTES OF A MEETING OF BRIGHSTONE PARISH COUNCIL CEMETERY  
COMMITTEE HELD in BRIGHSTONE SCHOOL HALL  
on WEDNESDAY 26<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2014 AT 7.55pm.**

**1.APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:** None received.

**2. MATTERS ARISING from the MINUTES OF 11<sup>th</sup> JUNE MEETING,  
PREVIOUSLY AGREED and SIGNED:**

Mr. Bridges has sprayed the car park for weeds.

The contractors have been asked to sweep tablets of any grass cuttings and the problem seems to be resolved.

The clearance of spoil has not yet been done but is soon to be cleared.

The stone wall and gates have now been completed. A private ceremony was held for the benefactor and a public opening ceremony was held with a blessing from Reverend Helen O'Sullivan. It is hoped that the benefactor of the stone wall and gates is also willing to donate funds for a stone wall around the bins.

Due to not having a meeting in September it was agreed to hold the next Cemetery Committee meeting on the 14<sup>th</sup> January, just before the main full Parish Council meeting.
