

**MINUTES OF AN EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF BRIGHSTONE PARISH
COUNCIL CEMETERY COMMITTEE HELD in SEELY HALL, BROOK
on WEDNESDAY 19th AUGUST 2015 AT 7.15pm.**

1.APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE: None

2. TO CONSIDER AND DISCUSS THE PROPOSAL OF A NEW BIN STORE AT THE PARISH CEMETERY:

The benefactor who paid for the cemetery wall and gates would also like to build a stone bin store.

The base has already been laid and works have now been put on hold for the location and the materials to be approved by the Parish Council.

The base has been laid in the car park next to the bench in the far right hand corner. The proposed design is a stone wall with quoined brick corners. At present the bricks are a contrasting red.

Examples of the red brick and a softer sandy colour brick was shown to the committee.

The committee agreed that the location was suitable but it was suggested that once the works have been completed the committee should consider relocating the bench and laying a gravel path to the water tap.

All of the committee agreed that the red brick was too dark and would recommend the softer sandy colour brick.
